<p>The government is provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2015 to 2016 and 2016 to 2017 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding, provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, was allocated to primary school headteachers. This funding was ring-fenced and therefore spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. The main purpose of the funding is to raise standards of teaching in physical education and increase children's participation in PE and Sport thus ensuring healthier lifestyles.</p>

<p>Our Sports Premium Funding over recent years has enabled us to take our children to more sporting events and other activities, broadening and deepening their knowledge and experience, as well as developing new skills and self-confidence. The funding of an excellent Sports Coach has provided every child in the school with outstanding sports teaching provision and expertise. All of our pupils have been eligible for this funding and every child has been able to undertake these activities that we have not been able to previously offer. The funding has made a difference to our sport and PE participation. We have monitored the use of clubs and have identified that participation has increased.
