<p><u>New School council format</u> AP – Children like it because they feel more part of it. Will the chair and the minute takers change?</p>	<p>KS will discuss the question with NB</p>
<p><u>Naming classes</u> JB – Book authors, Fruits, Saints, animals, countries, local roads, trees AP – Saints, trees, flowers, road names, football teams, animals FW – Cities, Fruits, weather, colours ED - disciple names, books, roads animals and Saints LL – Keep them the same, colours animals, weather, French numbers, Books, local roads, letters, super heroes, Saints, body parts</p> <p>The group discussed the idea of Saint names and local roads but felt that the disciples idea linked well with the school ethos – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John or road names around the school: Blanche, Cecil, St Albans, Frowyke</p>	<p>KS to agree the names with the rest of the school in assembly</p>
<p><u>Moving to three teams and naming them</u></p> <p>LL 50/50 said yes. Half said no. Similar to the ones above but also cars, athletes for names ED – Everyone agreed that we should change them to three teams because some groups have more than others and it doesn't quite fit. Sports, but thought a new set a values for the names eg Faith, Kindness etc. FW – majority wanted the change. They thought of similar names to the classes but a good one was instrument. AP – mostly said to keep 4 houses (6 to 4) but would be happy to change the house names – Harry Potter house? JB – wanted to keep 4 and rename them saints</p> <p>The chairs agreed that having three teams is a good idea but there was some reluctance because some felt they were used to it, and they didn't see the point of changing them. KS explained that there are 15 children in a year group which splits well into 3 but not into 4.
